



## **Archery Team selection for 2015 Island Games in Jersey**

2014 is the qualification year for any archer wishing to compete in the Jersey NatWest Island Games 2015. To qualify for entry Archers must be resident in Jersey for 6 months between the 2013 and 2015 games or have been born in Jersey.

Each island may submit teams of the following Archers :-

Compound Team of two ladies and four gents

Recurve Team of two ladies and four gents.

Qualification is based on the average of your highest 3 FITA scores \* from the year preceding the games. Therefore from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014 until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014.

Any archer wishing to compete should ensure that their scores are submitted to their club Records Officer no later than 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 who will be responsible for submitting them to the Secretary of the Archery Association of Jersey by 11<sup>th</sup> November 2014. For scores to be valid, they must be received from their club's Records Officer including the relevant official results list or the signed score sheet. Scores will be accepted from any designated club shoot where there are a minimum of 4 archers competing, or off island competitions provided they have been scored as per GNAS rules.

Team places will be offered to the Archers achieving the highest average scores in each discipline (Ladies Compound or Recurve, Gents Compound or Recurve), should those archers turn down a place it will then be offered to the next highest scoring archer and so on.

It should be noted that should juniors \*\* be offered a place they will need to be accompanied at the games( as per IGAJ requirements) by a parent or legal guardian who will be responsible for their safety and well being at all times.

## Notes

\*Gents FITA - 12 dozen arrows. 3 doz at 90 m, 3 doz at 70m, 3 doz at 50m, & 3 doz at 30m.

Ladies FITA -12 dozen arrows. 3 doz at 70m, 3 doz at 60m, 3 doz at 50, & 3 doz at 30m.

\*\* A junior is any Archer whose 18<sup>th</sup> birthday falls on or after the opening day of the games or the date of travel to the games whichever is the earliest.
